## Financial Aid Eligibility Stipulations and Guidelines, 2019-20

### Financial Aid Stipulations

JMBT scholarship students must:

1. Be enrolled in the Full Program\* and remain committed to attending the Full Program through the end of the year in May.
2. Comply with all rules and regulations of Ballet Theatre including, but not limited to, dress code, punctuality, general conduct, and class protocols.
3. Attend and be on time to all scheduled classes. Scholarship students may not be late to class more than 3 times or have more than 3 unexcused absences during the course of the program. Excused absences and lateness must be communicated to the office by a Parent/Guardian in advance of the start of class.
4. Participate in all scheduled classes and activities and other organizational programs as scheduled.
5. Seek and receive permission from artistic staff before enrolling in additional dance classes or accepting a performance engagement elsewhere.
